## Updated EPF Download Manager

**Primary Audience:** All Licensees

**What:**

An updated version (1.0.0.6) of the Electronic Product Fulfillment (EPF) Download Manager is now available at [https://epfws.usps.gov/ws/dnldmgrs/epfdnldmgr\\_1.0.0.6.zip](https://epfws.usps.gov/ws/dnldmgrs/epfdnldmgr_1.0.0.6.zip).

The updated version includes the following:

- EPF Terms of Agreement that Users MUST ACCEPT.
- If Users have not changed their passwords within 120 days, a password reset screen will request them to update their passwords.
- The link also provides access to updated Rest Web Services and Product Codes documentation to include SHA-256 Products.

***Before installing the current version, uninstall the old version first. Also the new version of the download manager uses a newer version of .NET. The upgrade is located at:***
