eInduction is available for Standard Mail® (including Non-Profit) letters and flats, Periodicals® letters and flats, Bound Printed Matter® flats and parcels, and First-Class Mail® letters and flats.

- Elimination of hard copy PS Form 8125, *Plant Verified Drop Shipment Clearance* document and PS Form 8017, *Expedited Plant Load Form*
- Efficient and streamlined mail induction process
- More flexible and dynamic Mail Preparation Process
- Transparency and Improved reporting
- Visibility with your mailings into the mailstream
- Support of special mail preparation/special mailers
