### Important points concerning color codes:

1. Color coding is an internal Postal Service procedure to ensure the timely processing, dispatch, and delivery of Standard Mail within established service standards.
2. If the Postal Service accepts a mailing before the posted critical entry time (CET) for that day, the day of receipt is designated as the arrival date.
3. If the Postal Service accepts a mailing after the posted CET for that day, the mailing will have an arrival day of the following applicable processing day.
4. Redirected mailings retain service standards associated with original destination entry point.
5. Holidays will not change the application of color codes. However, FAST appointment availability may differ on holidays.
6. Special procedures may apply to non-machinable, non-barcoded letters or flats mailed at saturation, high density, or basic carrier route with requested in-home dates drop shipped to a DDU or DSCF.

**Important points concerning destination entry Standard Mail:**

1. The service standards listed apply to the contiguous United States.
2. Drop shipments must arrive on time with a valid FAST appointment.
3. National critical entry time for palletized Standard Mail is 16:00 (4:00 p.m.), and 12:00 (Noon) for bedloaded shipments.
4. "Start-the-clock" Day Zero (Day-0) is the date when the clock starts for the purposes of service measurement.
5. Redirected mailings retain service standards associated with original destination entry point.
6. Facility operating hours and FAST's hours of drop shipment are locally determined. Check FAST for slot availability.
7. Holidays will not change the application of color codes. However, FAST appointment availability may differ on holidays.
8. Special procedures may apply to non-machinable, non-barcode letters or flats mailed at saturation, high density, or basic carrier route with requested in-home dates drop shipped to a DDU or DSCF.

5. Redirected mailings retain service standards associated with original destination entry point.
6. Facility operating hours and FAST's hours of drop shipment are locally determined. Check FAST for slot availability.
7. Color codes are administered by the Postal Service and pertain only to Standard Mail.
