

The Move to Competitive Street Addressing List is a text file. Use Word Pad to open the text file to ensure all data is displayed correctly.

ZIP Class – The ZIP Classification Code describes the type of ZIP area a 5-digit ZIP Code serves. A 'P' indicates the ZIP Code has PO Boxes only and a blank ZIP Class indicates both PO Box and street delivery.

PBSA NO Secondary – The MTC street address is in a Postal facility that is a standalone address. (i.e. not in a high-rise or sharing the primary number with other businesses).

PBSA SECONDARY NO CONFLICT – The MTC street address is in a Postal facility that shares the primary number with other businesses; however, the existing secondary numbers do not conflict with the PO Box numbers or the secondary numbers assigned to an MTC street address.

PBSA CONFLICT - The MTC street address is in a Postal facility that shares the primary number with other businesses and the existing secondary numbers conflict with the PO Box numbers. The MTC street address secondary numbers have been adjusted to eliminate any conflicts with the secondary numbers already in use.

OEB - The field following each range will determine if the range is Odd, Even or Both.

O = 'Odd' E = 'Even' B = 'Both'
